List, M.D., Ph.D. is the Global Therapeutic Area Head of Cardiovascular & Metabolism (CVM), leading a global team focused on creating new solutions for improving cardiovascular, metabolic, and retinal diseases. Jim has end-to-end research and development responsibility for the Janssen CVM portfolio, including drug discovery, clinical development, and external innovation. Jim joined Janssen in 2014.

Prior to Janssen, Jim spent a decade at Bristol-Myers Squibb in roles of increasing responsibility. He most recently served as Vice President, Diabetes Development with responsibility for the diabetes joint venture alliance with AstraZeneca, overseeing development and alliance activities for multiple diabetes medicines. During his time at Bristol-Myers Squibb, he played a key role in formulating pipeline strategy and in the development of several diabetes medicines.

Earlier in his career, he was a faculty member of Harvard Medical School with clinical responsibilities in General Endocrinology and Thyroid. Jim graduated from Stanford University and went on to complete his M.D. and Ph.D. from the University of Minnesota. He completed his medical training at Brigham and Women's Hospital, Boston Children's Hospital, and the Massachusetts General Hospital. Jim has been board certified in Internal Medicine, Pediatrics, and Endocrinology, and holds medical licenses in New Jersey and Massachusetts.
